A wire management system provides power, data and voice access throughout the work surface.

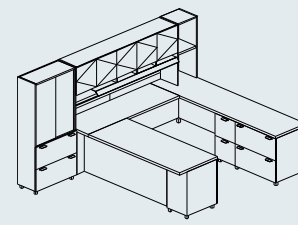
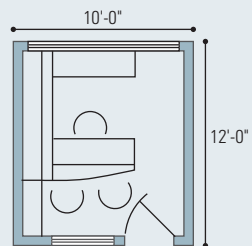

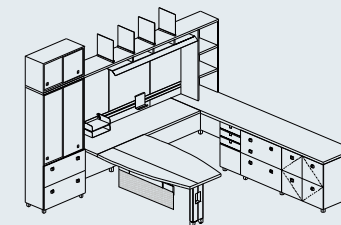


U-SHAPE WALL UNIT

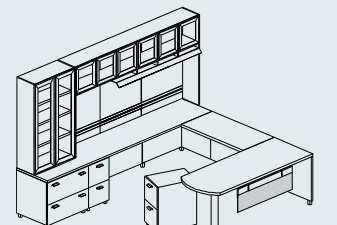

An accessory track holds items to organize your workstation.

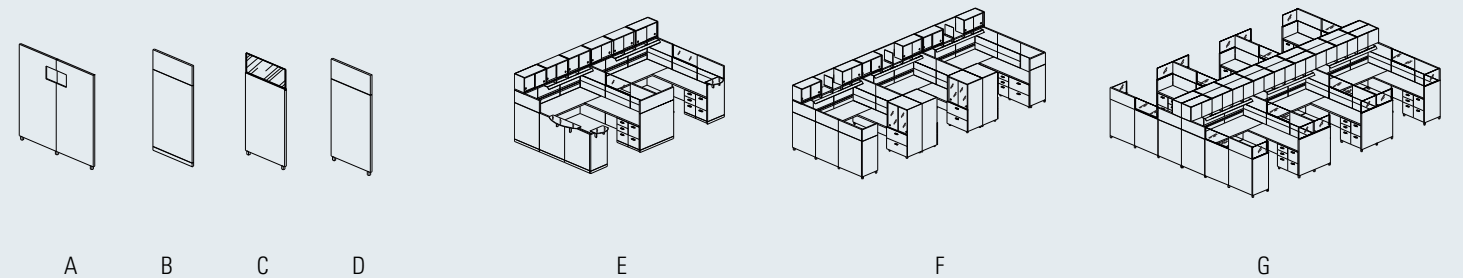


Panel options include all wood, glass or acrylic windows, and pass-through windows.



WORKSTATIONS

Everyone wants a window office. Xchange workstations allow you to bring this symbol of the private office, along with other casegoods features, to open space environments. Workstations can be specified in side-to-side, or back-to-back, configurations. The 4-inch recessed structure of Xchange allows for easy wire management in either configuration. This can be accessed through a removal wood tile above the work surface and a removable modesty panel below the work surface. Workstations can be customized to meet architectural conditions.

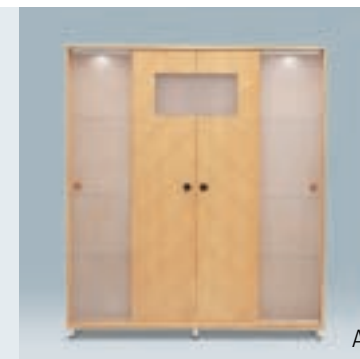

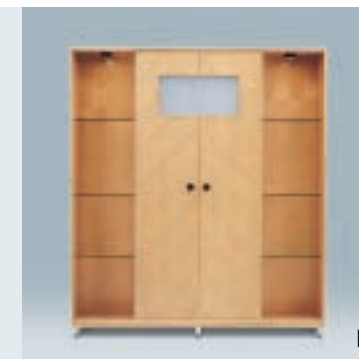


RECEPTION STATIONS AND CONFERENCING

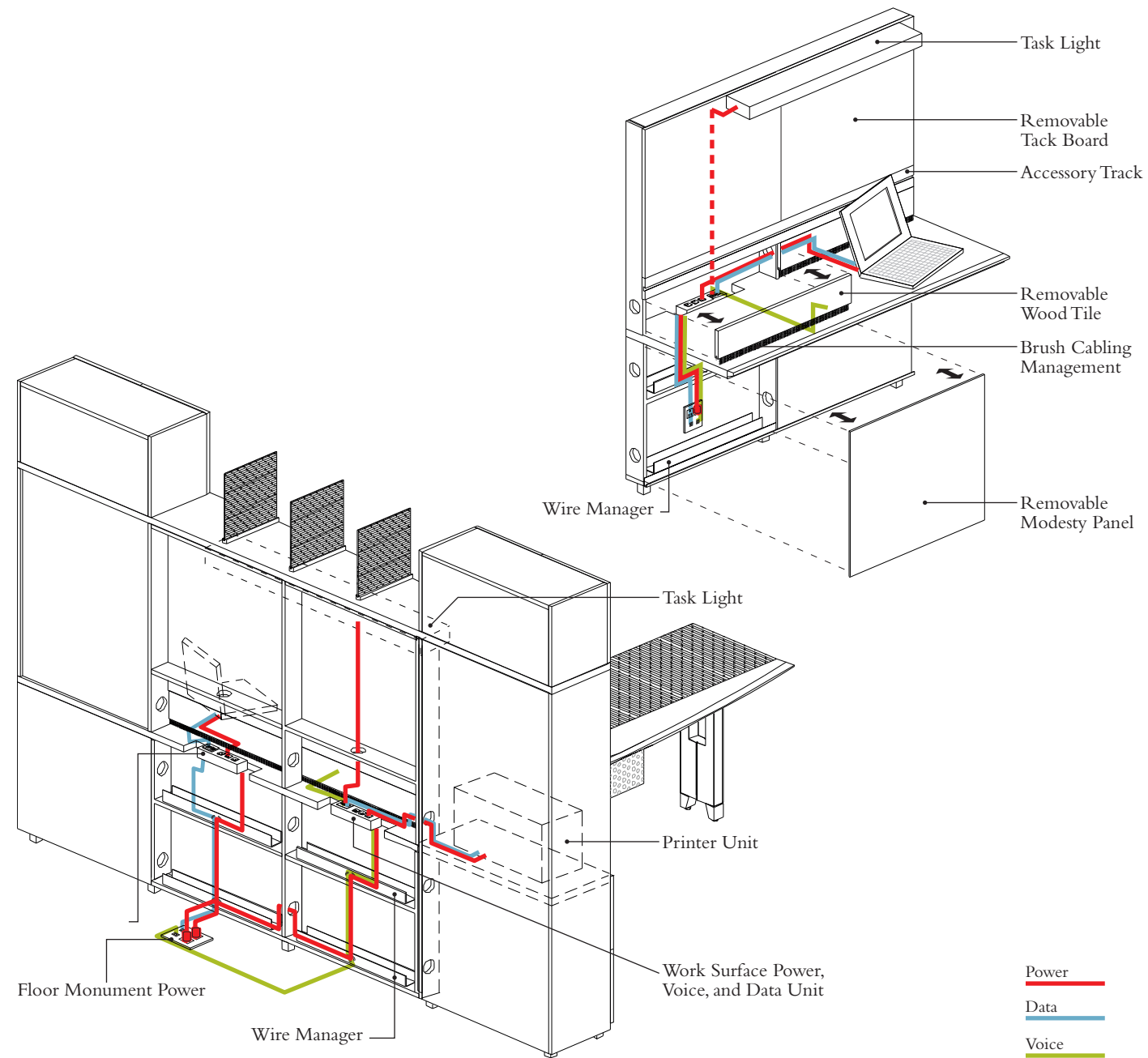

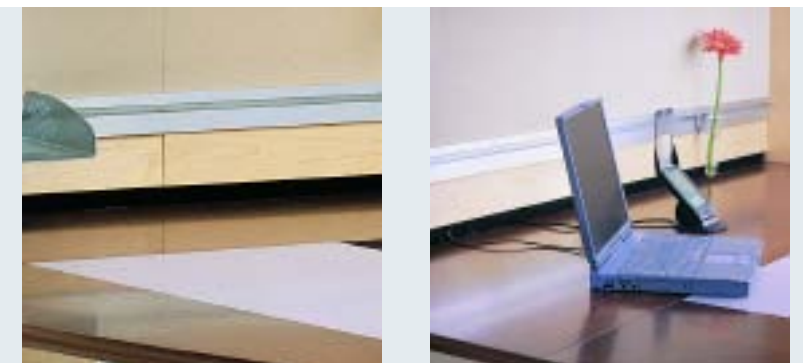

WIRE MANAGEMENT

Xchange provides integrated wire management accessible throughout the system as indicated in the above drawing. This is accomplished in two unique ways. The first involves removable six-inch horizontal tiles located below the accessory track. This allows easy access to voice, data and power anywhere along the work surface. The second includes removable modesty panels, which also achieve easy access to voice, data and power. In addition, wire managers run behind the modesty panel for excess cable. These two concepts can be used together or separately for cost reduction.
